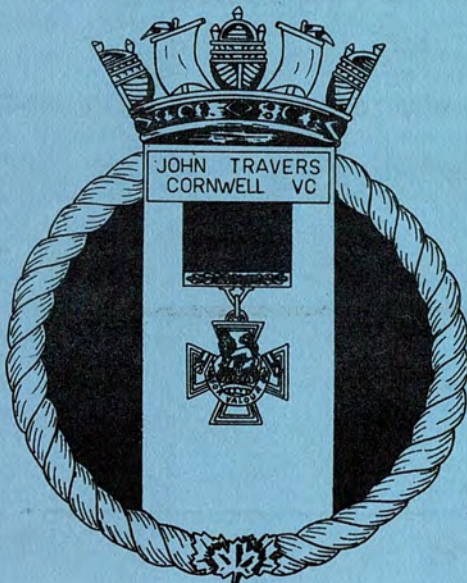

INSPECTING OFFICER - CAPTAIN (N) W. N. FOX-DECENT, CD

Cdr Fox-Decent was born and educated in Winnipeg. He joined the Naval Reserve in 1954 as a University Naval Training Division cadet at age 17 and was promoted to sub-lieutenant after completing three summers of training.

In 1961 he commanded the auxiliary mine sweeper H.M.C.S. Scatari. During the summers of 1962 and 1963 he commanded the mine sweeper H.M.C.S. Porte St. Jean and was Squadron Commander of the Reserve Training Squadron in the Great Lakes. In 1967 Cdr Fox-Decent was promoted to Lieutenant commander and appointed Personnel Administration Officer in the Winnipeg Naval Reserve Unit. During the summer of 1970 he was the Senior Naval Reserve Officer afloat on the West Coast. He was appointed Commanding Officer, H.M.C.S. Chippawa 1973. On January 1, 1976 he was promoted to the rank of Captain.

In Civilian life Cdr Fox-Decent is a professor of political studies at the University of Manitoba. He resides in Charleswood with his wife and two children.
